## 1) Location

- Based in RBKC, working in RBKC
- Based in RBKC and working in RBKC as well as elsewhere ( % of users in borough or amount of local residents users tbc)
- Based elsewhere but working in RBKC

## 2) Legal status

- Registered charities
- CIOs
- CiC
- Cooperatives but not CLGs
- Residents associations but not residents
- Unincorporated associations

#### 3) Size/institutional status

- No Major orgs (national or big income, ie, NAVCA or V&A)
- No institutions
- No Schools or Churches

except Churches which do wider community work

<u>except</u> private schools which are registered as charities and do wider community work

## **Explanatory notes**

a) 'Churches' (section 3 above) does not mean the same as 'faith groups' (the generic term used by Civi) which would naturally be <u>included</u> if they meet the criteria in 1) and 2)]
