

CRITERIA FOR KCSC 'CORE ORGS' (MEMBER ORGANISATIONS)

Updated June 2021

Organisations must meet all three criteria

See notes section for explanation about particular examples

1) Location

- Based in RBKC, working in RBKC
- Based in RBKC and working in RBKC as well as elsewhere (% of users in borough or amount of local residents users tbc)
- Based elsewhere but working in RBKC

2) Legal status

- Registered charities
- CIOs
- CiC
- Cooperatives but not CLGs
- Residents associations but not residents
- Unincorporated associations

3) Size/institutional status

- No Major orgs (national or big income, ie, NAVCA or V&A)
- No institutions
- No Schools or Churches

except Churches which do wider community work

except private schools which are registered as charities and do wider community work

Explanatory notes

- a) **'Churches'** (section 3 above) does not mean the same as 'faith groups' (the generic term used by Civi) which would naturally be included if they meet the criteria in 1) and 2)]

b) **National organisations** (section 3 above) are not included as members, even if they provide services in the borough

BUT if they have a federated structure with separate (if affiliated) organisations working at local level like Age UK which has Age UK K&C – they can be members.
