

# RBKC Youth Review 2023

## **Purpose of Review**

### The review will:

Understand the system around children and young people that includes learning and inclusion; employability; safety and Serious Youth Violence; mental health and wellbeing; and sports and physical activity

Systematically map and review the offer of available services around children and young people (funded and unfunded) to inform a holistic approach to commissioning youth services and determining where funding is targeted

Explore how we can utilise community assets better to support children and young people's outcomes, creating efficiencies in the youth model

Align and integrate the youth and early help offer better with schools to respond to increasing rates of serious youth violence in the borough

Consider which groups of children and young people do not currently access the youth sector and why, so that services can be made more accessible and inclusive

Develop a solution to better connect and promote the youth offer to children and young people in the borough, together with libraries, leisure, schools and communities

Ensure the voices of young people are at the centre of the review

#### Key messages during engagement

The review will build on the outcomes, priorities and principles established through the engagement that was part of the Children and Young People's Plan

> Opportunity to understand and map out the wider youth offer beyond what the Council funds so that we are able to promote these services and ensure positive uptake

While there are no additional savings profiled this year, the Council is facing significant financial challenges and children's services need to deliver £1.4m savings

Opportunity to build on the foundations of the 2018 Youth Review

The review will identify where, and how, provision can be accessed and further strengthened, building on the current partnership and collaborative approach including the potential introduction of the Youth Mark Accreditation
