What happens next?

Staying engaged

- Plans for wide engagement to keep the sector up to date, specifically on ICP and ICS developments through this Bi-borough network
- We would like active participation e.g feeding in your views on thematic areas of work emerging out of the ICP back to the ICP; attending meetings to represent those views
- Continue to utilise KCSC and One Westminster's existing Health and Wellbeing Forums on more general health and wellbeing, public health and adult social care issues.

What happens next?

Strategic involvement

- KCSC and One Westminster will set up a smaller strategic group of VCOs across the Bi-borough that will put some additional time into VCS strategic development
- The group will consist of 3ST VCS representatives i.e VCS representatives that already sit on the 3ST NWL strategy group – currently there are 3 VCS reps from K&C and 3 from Westminster
- Attending VCS strategic meetings to plan how we represent the interests of residents and the VCS and how the VCS can develop its own proposals
- Participating in ICP Sub Groups/Workstreams eg discharge, winter planning, mental health etc

What happens next?

Being a part of the strategic group - What's required?

- Understanding the issues
- Feeding back to the VCS strategic group and to the wider VCS network
- Supporting the design of opportunities for the VCS that arise from the ICP sub groups/workstreams as well as helping to shape new opportunities
- To find the time to participate may require being in a senior level position within your organisation
