Part of the community charity, Groundwork London, *Green Doctors* are a team of expert energy advisers. For 15 years the *Green Doctors* have been helping households in London save money, stay warm and improve energy efficiency at home.

We work in partnership with London Boroughs, Housing Associations and other organisations to deliver **free phone consultations/home visits** where we *give advice on bills* and provide referrals to further services to improve health and well-being of residents.

Improve health and reduce the impacts of cold homes

## Health impacts of living in a cold home

#### Body's reaction to cold living spaces

- The body burns excessive levels of calories to keep itself warm more hunger
- Healthy people more likely to develop health conditions and worsen existing conditions
- Reduced immunity to viruses immune system compromised
- Cardiovascular illness, e.g. coronary heart disease, stroke, hypertension
- Respiratory illness, e.g. seasonal flu, COPD (chronic obstructive pulmonary disease), asthma attacks

#### Black mould spores caused by condensation

- Respiratory complications-persistent cough, allergic reactions
- Skin rashes
- Potential link to chronic fatigue syndrome

#### Other risks

- Poor mental health
- Impacts cognitive function
- Increased risk of falls



# Other impacts of cold homes

- Households have to make tough decisions about where to spend their income, e.g. choosing between heating and eating
- 'Spatial shrink' households turn heating off in some rooms, sometimes to one room only
- Stress and anxiety about unaffordable fuel bills
- Social isolation less willing to invite friends and family to home
- Children struggling to complete homework



#### What advice is available?

- Personalised advice on energy bills
- Energy saving tips, encouraging behavioral change
- Financial help:

Supporting residents applying to discounts or other benefits they may be entitled to:

- \*Warm Home Discount (£ 140 on-off payment electricity bill)
- \*Water Help (50 % discount on water bill)
- \*Water Sure (to cap the water bill)
- **Priority Service Register** a free utility support service to help people in vulnerable situations





#### What advice is available?

- Explaining how smart meter could help to save energy and money
- Fuel debt management Providing energy and water debt advice and supporting residents to access grants
- Help to apply to larger grants to improve home and heating efficiency (eg, boiler replacement, insulations, etc)
- Delivering/installing free energy-saving items such as draft proofing strips/LED light bulbs/showerheads, etc
- Signposting to other services for additional support with local organisations





## **Eligibility Criteria**

- oFuel poor, on a low income (under £ 15,900) or in receipt of any means tested benefits); and/or:
- OWith a long term health condition (such as respiratory/ circulatory disease or mental health condition)
- People with a disability
- Older people (65 and over)
- OHouseholds with children under 5

# The Ask

- Be more aware of the issues people experience from living in cold homes
- Reassure residents there is help available by signposting them
- Refer and encourage vulnerable residents to have a consultation with a Green Doctor in order to help protect their health. Give them a leaflet.
- If you suspect someone is experiencing fuel poverty

   ask them questions like:

Are you struggling to keep your home warm? Are you concerned about utility bills?

### **Success stories**

#### Case study 1

A resident, aged 73, who has long term health issues was rung at a point when he had run out of food in his flat. As well as doing a low income tariff application for his water bill we were able to get him an emergency food delivery from his local foodbank and sign him up for weekly deliveries and referred him to the local fire service to check his home for fire safety.

#### Case study 2

We called one resident, aged 54 years, unemployed and living alone. We were able to save her £290 by helping her switch energy provider, get her a 50% discount on her energy bill through a Water Sure Plus application and £418 from the Customer Assistant Fund.
