

Introduction to Safeguarding Children (Level 1) (half-day workshop)

*Please note this workshop will cost **£50** to private and profit making services. It is free to statutory and voluntary sector agencies.*

This workshop introduces the concept of safeguarding children including an exploration of why safeguarding is important, the laws and legislation underpinning our responsibilities, what to look out for and what to do if something is concerning.

It is ideal for those practitioners who are new to working with children and perhaps do not have a great deal of direct contact with children on a daily basis.

Please note that this workshop is an introduction, therefore is not suitable for those who are in more direct or senior roles unless they have no previous safeguarding experience.

Learning Outcomes:

- An opportunity to address and manage personal attitudes and beliefs
- Gain a basic understanding of the legislative framework
- Gain a basic understanding of how to raise concerns appropriately within each agency
- Have an understanding of possible signs and symptoms of abuse and harm
- Know who to contact about concerns and for making referrals
