# Scaling up in a Social Prescribing Context:

1. **Creating referral pathways** with the NHS/ Primary Care Networks (GPs) and Social Prescribing Link workers
2. Be able to demonstrate **clear outcomes**, not just activities i.e. improvements in confidence and wellbeing among service users, maintaining a healthy lifestyle
3. **Building capacity** in service users via participatory projects, train the trainer models
4. **Partner** with other local organisations to deliver joint services
5. Increase **diversity** of service users
