Tactics and Prevention

- Op Venice As per presentation

- ANPR

- CCP by NPT re education of owners and visible property in vehicle.
- Partnership work with car companies re keyless technology

Violent Crime

- Violent Crime CW up 5.4%, FH up 4.1%, BS up 9.4% in rolling year up to 07/18
- Comparable to increase seen across the MPS
- However, offences of violence with injury have seen a drop in the same period: June 17 and June 18
- Kensington & Chelsea 0.3%
- Number of Knife Injury Victims u25

TOTAL POLICING

- Kensington & Chelsea 2016/17 to 2017/18 seen increase
- Reduction in number of Knife Injury Victims over 25
- Kensington & Chelsea 2016/17 to 2017/18 seen a decrease
- Over 33% of knife enabled offences are robberies, assaults account for around 14% of knife crime



METROPOLITAN

- A variety of work is being conducted across the BCU to tackle the rise in violent crime, for example:
- Strategic bespoke knife crime plans targeting specific problems e.g. TTCG taskings / CPT
- NPT Patrols in areas / Weapons sweeps
- Enforcement innovative CBOs targeting high risk subjects, increased use of stop & search for weapons, focused activity on HKCs, reduce knife crime offenders RUI'd
- Effective use of VCTF serials supported by BCU resources relevant briefing & taskings
- Sceptre activity weeks BCU wide response
- Op Domain increase open source skills for identification & removal of gang videos inciting violence
- Op Venice & Op Goodthink response to moped crime
- Closer working relationship across FH/BS/CW Gangs & proactive units improved information sharing and resilience
