










Police Response – New Tactics



Forensic Tagging – help to identify suspects and scooters involved in P2W crime



Motorcycles – specific design to assist pursuit of scooters / crime prevention



ProSpike – remote controlled stinger – increased safety for officers and more effective in stopping scooters committing further offences







Forensic Tagging – How it Works



- Private industry approached with design brief to produce hand-held spray canister, to link offenders and scooters involved in crime
- Canister discharges uniquely coded water-like substance containing fluorescent dye glows blue under UV torch



- Stays on clothing and articles indefinitely, and on the skin for 6-8 weeks
- Clothing / vehicles / suspects with dye on them can be analysed to determine time, date, location & circumstances of when dye was discharged
- Ensure everyone in custody is examined under a UV lamp



- Use UV lamps at every opportunity on clothing, vehicles, suspects, property and on S.18 searches
- Canisters issued Met-wide
- 1200+ officers trained to use the spray

ProSpike

- ProSpike is a mechanised spike system that deploys a bed of hollow spikes, like a stinger, but is activated remotely removes officers from harm
- Fast deployment & retraction of spikes (1-2 seconds)
- Is effective against motorbikes, cars, and lorries
- Pairing devices allows multiple deployment of ProSpike by one officer
- Can be used as a fixed or mobile option for spontaneous or pre planned operations
- Capability to be hardwired to CCTV / ANPR

Venice – Conviction Success

Three males responsible for a series of motorcycle thefts and moped-enabled robberies in central London sentenced to a total of over 20 years' imprisonment

- 12 years 6 months conspiracy to commit robbery, seven counts of theft and two counts of attempted theft of motorcycles
- 3 years seven counts of theft and two counts of attempted theft of motorcycles
- 5 years five counts of robbery

Four males, including three juveniles, responsible for 103 moped-enabled offences, sentenced to combined total of 18 years, 5 months

- 5 years 3 months
- 4 years 2 months
- 4 years 2 months






Theft of scooter offences – recent months 2017-18



892 less victims 22.2% reduction


Scooters used in crime offences – recent months 2017-18
