The Pilotlight Programme

The Pilotlight Programme typically lasts between ten to twelve months and is facilitated by a Pilotlight project manager. You will meet with your Pilotlighters and project manager on a monthly basis for two and a half hours. Meetings take place in Central London (England and Wales charities) and in Glasgow/Edinburgh (Scotland charities), with the exception of one visit to your charity's site. Many projects result in a strategic business plan for your organisation, but you will set the aims of the project after the first few meetings.
