

SURVEY OF COMMUNITY MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES

- At the start of 2016, a questionnaire was sent to 850 people who received community mental health services.
 Responses were received from 207 people at West London Mental Health NHS Trust.
- Based on their responses, WLMHT was given a score out of 10 for each question (the higher the score the better).
- For each question, WLMHT also received a rating of 'About the same', 'Better' or 'Worse'.







WLMHT ONE OF WORST PERFORMING

Ten areas assessed.

WLMHT underperformed in five out of ten areas.

- Health & Social Care Workers listening, feeling listened to
- Organising care being informed of who is in charge of organising their care
- Planning care being involved as much as they would like in agreeing their care
- Support and wellbeing support for physical health needs
- Support and wellbeing support to find financial advice or benefits
- Overall poor experience

CQC has written to WLMHT to urge them to review their results and to outline what actions they will take to address the areas of concern.
